Answer: Accept any of the following: to walk, swim, fly, and quack like a duck.

- What did Sheep do when Turkey was learning to act like a duck?

Answer: He watched and laughed.

- Why did the farmer decide he'd have to take Sheep instead of Turkey?

Answer: Answers will vary.

- Why did Sheep say "Woof, woof"?

Answer: Answers will vary.
